### Teaching Portfolio (selected courses and activities)

My teaching experience covers all pedagogical methodologies: group work, multi-disciplinary problem oriented work, supervision of project groups (up to 6 students), seminars and lectures to classes (20-30 students) and larger gatherings in auditoriums (50-200 students). I teach in Danish and in English. I have taught internationally in English to international Ph.D. students and post doctoral students in Denmark, Croatia, Alaska USA, New York USA, Greenland and Russia.

Planning of syllabus was conducted by myself or as a member of a group of colleagues. Usually I distribute my Power Point posters to the students before a lecture, and I prepare them with illustrations relevant to the themes presented. A mixture of seminars and group work based on the students own choice of a problem to be analysed within the syllabus usually gives the best learning. It should be mentioned though that I also have experience with traditional discipline oriented teaching, e.g. a two semester course twice a week in economics at the HA education at The Copenhagen School of Business Economics and Administration (today CBS) and in economics for political science at the University of Greenland.
